The 2019 NM Open State Cup is right around the corner and we would like to remind parents and spectators that we have a **zero tolerance** rule when it comes to negative parent/spectator behavior. NMYSA will have staff and field marshals observing all State Cup games and anyone acting inappropriately will be asked to leave. Games can be terminated due to abusive language or behavior from a parent or spectator and your child's team may have to forfeit that game. Please know, we reserve the right to videotape all participants and spectators.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

- It is essential that we give the officials the respect and authority they deserve. It is never appropriate for parents and spectators to yell at referees.
- NO abusive language or behavior towards a coach, player, official or other spectator.
- Parents/spectators may not approach a referee before, during or after a game.
- NO parents/spectators are allowed to be on the field before, during or after a game.
- Parents/Spectators must never confront opposing team coaches or players. Parent concerns should be addressed with your team coach/club.
- Your coaches are responsible for your behavior so please be respectful to them and all they do for your kids.
- Only coaches will be given referee evaluation forms for completion after each game.
