



## NMYSA Insurance Information Filing a Soccer Related Injury Claim

The NMYSA accident insurance benefit is a secondary insurance policy with a \$500.00 deductible.

How to file a Claim:

The team coach or league/club official must report the injury of the registered player, participating in a sanctioned event to the league Registrar/Risk Manager, (in accordance with league policies) or direct to the State Office, as soon as possible following the incident. Insurance claims must be filed within 90 days of the incident.

The league registrar/official reports the injury in writing to the NMYSA State Office via the "NMYSA Injury Report" form located on the NMYSA website at [www.nmysa.net](http://www.nmysa.net) under forms.

Upon receipt of the injury report, the NMYSA State Office will mail claim instructions to the injured member/member's parents.

The member parent or guardian completes the Pullen insurance claim forms and returns them to the NMYSA State office.

The NMYSA State Office will verify the claim information, sign and mail the forms to K & K Insurance.

Member/member's parents will be contacted by K & K Insurance upon their receipt. Member parents can then communicate directly with K & K concerning the claim. If the member has other insurance, submit the itemized bills to the primary carrier first. The primary carrier will send an Explanation of Benefits (EOB). This along with any other receipts can be forwarded to K & K Insurance.
