

Hello League/Club Registrars!

LeagueOne has implemented some new enhancements that I think everyone will enjoy. Below is a summary of those enhancements. Also, there are a couple of NMYSA announcements for your information as well.

LeagueOne

1. There is a new report feature that will allow you to create customizable reports under the "Admin" icon on the LeagueOne system. The existing reports are still available, however, you can now create reports specific to your needs!
2. Pass Cards are now available in three different formats due to changes in the USYSA requirements that only USYSA pass cards to be used at USYSA events. For the most part, everyone will use the USYSA pass card option. However, if you have a team traveling to a non-USYSA event, you must print an additional set of pass cards to be used at the non-USYSA event. These cards are available in the "print pass card" option in your drop down labeled as "non-USYSA pass cards".
3. In the past, if a parent/coach asked to be removed from our email list, we had to delete their email address from the system altogether. Now there is an option on the staff record screen to unsubscribe them from the email list. This function however does not delete the email address from our system so parents/coaches will still receive critical emails such as confirmation emails.
4. The LeagueOne league scheduler program is now available for all of our member leagues. If you wish to use the scheduling program, please contact the State office so that we can establish security and a password for you.

NMYSA

1. Our insurance policy renews annually September 1, of each year and we automatically mail/email out the liability insurance certificates to the certificate holders.(this was done August 26th). Copies of those certificates are also sent to the League Offices for their records. If you have a new practice/playing facility, please contact our office so that we may issue them a certificate of insurance. Also, there has been a change in the deductible for our secondary accident insurance policy to \$250.00 beginning with the 2010-2011 season.
2. Our New Mexico Governor Bill Richardson has once again proclaimed the month of September as US Youth Soccer Month in New Mexico. To celebrate, we encourage our affiliate members to host special events during the month of September. If your league wants to get involved in the celebrations, please contact the state office as we are happy to help.

3. If you have teams traveling to USYSA Far West Regional Championships in Boise, Idaho for 2011, please let them know that NMYSA was required to block hotel rooms for the event for our attending teams. Reservations cannot be made outside of the New Mexico room block, as this event once again is a “stay to play” event. More information concerning the block will be issued at a later date.
