Class held on Monday and Wednesday from 10-10:50 am during the spring semester at ENMU – begins January 20 and ends May 5.

Course participants will have the opportunity to earn two college credits from ENMU and the following coaching certifications from the New Mexico Youth Soccer Association:

Youth Module I

Focused on running youth soccer sessions for 5-8 year old children. This module discusses the developmental characteristics of children within this age range and the implications of these characteristics on designing and running training sessions.

Youth Module II

Focused on running youth soccer sessions for 9-12 year old children. This module discusses the developmental characteristics of children within this age range and the implications of these characteristics on designing and running training sessions.

"E" Certificate

This course combines field and classroom instruction in intermediate coaching and teaching methodology. This is an entry level course for all competitive coaches and is geared towards working with 12-15 year old players. This course will cover the components of the game, principles of play, the role of the coach, organization of a training session, team management and administration, risk management and prevention and care of injuries.
