Arizona New Mexico Development League

This is the 2nd year for ANMDL, which provides participating teams with competitive league games between teams from Arizona and New Mexico, while keeping the cost and travel expense as low as possible. Last year, 18 teams (6 U11 Boys, 6 U12 Boys, 6 U12 Girls) played 8 games each.

This year, U11 (2009), U12 (2008), and U13 (2007) Boys and Girls teams will compete. Maximum 8 teams per division (4 from Arizona, 4 from New Mexico). The cost is \$1,000 per team for a guaranteed 8 games each season

Spring 2019: January 11-12, 2020 (AZ), February 1-2, 2020 (NM), March 7-8, 2020 (NM)

US Youth Soccer Desert Conference

The US Youth Soccer Desert Conference is one of 13 Conferences under the US Youth Soccer Leagues Program in the Multi-State Tier. The Desert Conference consists of teams primarily from Nevada, Arizona, Utah, New Mexico and Colorado. The top teams in the Conference will earn advancement to the US Youth Soccer Regional Championships, part of the US Youth Soccer National Championship Series, as well as a chance to earn a coveted spot in the National Tier of the Leagues Program, the US Youth Soccer National League.

US Youth Soccer National League

The US Youth Soccer National League competition is for the nation's top teams in the 14U, 15U, 16U, 17U, 18U and 19U boys and girls age groups. The 14U through 18U divisions consist of up to 32 teams per gender age group, while the 19U age group features up to 16 teams for each gender. The National League offers additional exposure to collegiate, professional and U.S. National Team coaches and offers the highest level of competition in the country as each team must earn their place in the league.

There are three means to earning automatic qualification into the National League:

72 Regional Championship winners/finalists/representatives

96 returning National League division top finishers

168 Regional League qualifiers

The NMYSA Target United Cup tournament (formerly known as Kohl's Cup) is open to any boys or girls team in the age groups U-8 through U-15. Teams will be bracketed by skill as much as possible. This is a program-wide tournament / carnival / festival for recreational, intermediate, and advanced teams from across the state, with the only caveat being that no team may participate in both the Target United Cup and the US Youth Soccer New Mexico Open State Cup.

The 2020 Target United Cup will be held at the New Mexico Soccer Tournament Complex at Santa Ana Pueblo, Bernalillo, NM, May 9-10, 2020.

New Mexico State Cup

The US Youth Soccer New Mexico Open State Cup is a part of the State, Regional, and National Championship program of US Youth Soccer. Annual winners of each age/gender group from the 14 National State Associations in Region IV advance to the Far West Regional Tournament in June of each year. Regional winners U-13 through U-19 advance to the annual US Youth Soccer National Championship Tournament.

The 2019 US Youth Soccer New Mexico Open State Cup was held April 27 to May 19, 2019. Winning teams (U-13 through U-19) represented New Mexico at the 2019 Far West Regional Tournament in Boise, Idaho June 17-23, 2019. The U-12 State Cup Champions qualified for the US Youth Soccer Far West Regional Championships in Norco, CA June 11-16, 2019. This was a 9v9 event for West Region U12 State Champions.

NMYSA Young Olympians Program (YOP)

The Young Olympians Program (YOP) serves as an introduction to ODP. YOP caters to players in three age groups; players born up to two years below the youngest ODP age group as well as the same age of the youngest ODP age group. YOP training pools are trained by the ODP coaching staff in a competitive training environment with the emphasis on player development and evaluation. The YOP training sessions take place during the spring season and in the summer. The program is aimed at age eligible Elite level and High level competitive club players.


