New Mexico Youth Soccer Association Annual General Meeting, August 15, 2020 Via Zoom at 11:00 AM Executive Director Report Gloria Faber

So much has changed since the last AGM, it seems decades ago rather than just over a year. As you can guess, we were once again met with tremendous change at the state and National levels of soccer. At USYS, the CEO, Chris Moore resigned and was later replaced by new CEO, Skip Gilbert. At USSF's, the longtime CEO, Dan Flynn, resigned and was replaced by Will Wilson, (still a mystery to us due to COVID). USSF's President Carlos Cordeiro also resigned, (amid the Women's National Team lawsuit/scandal) and was replaced by than Vice President, Cindy Parlow Cone, (now USSF President). Other USSF key staff, Brian Remedi and Jay Berhalter were casualties of the "changing of guard". However, Caitlin Carducci, Manager of Member Programs, remains intact and is continuing to provide communications/connectivity to USSF.

At the NMYSA state office, we lost both Nate Guadreault, (went into teaching), and Simon Rothman who ran our ODP program. Simon's roll/duties were combined with the Technical Director position, so we were finally able to hire one fulltime person in that roll. In September, we welcomed Rick Flores as the new fulltime Technical Director! As most of you know, Rick hit the ground running, visiting almost all of our member affiliates, prior to the COVID shutdown. We also welcomed Michael Posen, Programs Administrator, to help run and grow programming at NMYSA. Most of you already knew Michael as he was an NMYSA Board member, (District Commissioner and Director of Cups and Games). These two fulltime positions combined with Mysha's part time position have kept the office humming through the COVID-19 craziness.

As with many, so much of NMYSA's focus has shifted from programming to reorganizing/postponing/cancelling/reinventing and refunding/rescheduling events/registrations. In March, we closed the office due to the public health order and Mysha and Mike worked from home until June, (until non-essential business could reopen). While away, Mysha focused on training/onboarding affiliates to the new Stack platform and processing system refunds for several of our affiliates. Currently, she is working on procedures for registration/setup that we hope to have out soon. Michael used the downtime to help clean up the website and focus on communications as well as a pleather of projects. Michael also took on the job of Director of Instruction, for the NMSRC. We have all adapted to the virtual world and are learning to do business in new ways. We offered virtual soccer training activities and e-sports (FIFA tournaments) during the "stay at home order". Now though, we are extremely anxious to get NM kids out playing soccer and to be back to in person (masked



face to masked face) doing business. We believe that the positive effects of youth sports for the children's physical, mental and emotional wellbeing are important consideration and are working with the NM governor's office to get kids back playing sports again. Safely returning kids to soccer activity will remain our number 1 priority.

# **Programs**

#### ANMDL

Unfortunately, we ended up cancelling the ANMDL due to lack of participation on Arizona's part. We are not giving up on this concept though but will look to do something more with El Paso, Arizona and New Mexico in the future.

# APS/NMYSA Middle School League

The middle school league was a resounding success, (until COVID), for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row. We had our highest numbers of participations, 100% participation of APS middle schools, (some schools had multiple teams) with growth in unique registrations, 860 new players and 1076 total participants. Regrettably, we were only able to get one week of games played before the shutdown. Nevertheless, the City completely funded the program and has committed the funds for the 2021 season too!

# State Cup/NM Cup/Tournaments

We had 80 teams register for State Cup but eventually cancelled the event due to COVID. Despite that, were able to refund teams their entire entry fee and retrieve the NCS paid entry fees. NM Cup along with all other April-September tournaments were cancelled resulting in only 12 sanctioned tournaments with 805 teams. Further, our sponsorship form Visit Albuquerque also ceased due to event cancellations.

#### **TOPSoccer**

We applied for and received a grant of \$1600 from US Youth Soccer for TOPSoccer equipment and to start new TOPS programs. The equipment has been purchased and will be distributed, (to those that need it) once we reengage. Shout out to the Corrales TOPSoccer program, that Michael and his wife run, as it was featured on the local news and recognized for the benefits of the program for kids with disabilities. Moreover, we have two new potential programs, Los Lunas and another in Albuquerque that we hope to get up and running in 2021.

# Innovate to Grow - Futsal/Panna Cage

We applied for and received an Innovate to Grow grant from USSF for futsal startup/equipment and for the purchase of a Panna Cage. We proposed hosting 4 futsal events to engage kids in the game and generate interest with our affiliates. We also purchased a Panna Cage with the



intent of visiting existing/potential membership to host registration/social events. We will get back to this project once allowable.

#### ODP/YOP

The ODP program proved successful in 2020 as we had 12 teams participate in ODP Regional Championships with two teams in the semi-finals, 5 teams that finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in their brackets, 3 teams finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> in bracket and only 2 teams finishing at the bottom of their respective brackets. We had 44 boys and 39 girls invited to ODP camp, 10 Boys and 8 Girls selected to the West Region ODP pools and 4 Boys/2 Girls selected to participate in International events. Congratulations to these outstanding players!

For next season, USYS has announced a partnership with the MLS which will provide a pathway for our ODP players. They have also partnered with the GA-Girls Academy to provide another pathway for the girls ODP players.

#### **Desert Conference**

17 New Mexico teams were selected for participation in the Desert Conference National League and NM had a great showing. Congratulations the Rio Rapids 05 Girls who were crowned the Desert Conference champions in the 05 Girls division, (also the 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers in National League), the Rio Rapids 04 Girls who finished second in the Desert Conference 05 Girls division, the Rush 03 Boys and NMSA 08 Boys who finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in Desert Conference in their respective divisions. Kudos to these teams for an outstanding showing!

For 20-21, USYS has modernized the National League and added showcase events for an additional scouting opportunity for teams/players.

#### General

- We are continuing to onboard leagues/clubs to the new Stack system during the fall and beyond
- We are working with New Mexico legislators, Bernalillo County and the City of Albuquerque for fields at Mesa Del Sol. We are also wanting to host a Youth Sports/Soccer day at the legislature during the next session to promote soccer and the soccer needs throughout the state.
- We will continue to update our COVID Safe Practices/Return to Activity protocols as new information develops

I was honored to join NMYSA staff this year and it has certainly been a whirlwind. Gloria's leadership has been outstanding, and I learn something new from her nearly every day. Working with Rick and Mysha has been truly great and the environment here in the office could not be better! It has also been great to gain a greater insight into how the members across the state are running their programs. Working together with everyone has been a pleasure and even now in challenging times the resiliency of the NM soccer has never been more evident. I can't wait to see what innovative programs and practices we will see come out when we can safely return to the pitch.

## APS/ABC Community Schools/NMYSA Middle School League

The NMYSA Middle School League kicked off with its first match on March 11<sup>th</sup> and we had 29 middle schools participating this year with one school even having two teams for each gender. Unfortunately, COVID cancelled the season shortly after that first match. Working with APS and the City we were still able to pass on the now much-needed stipend checks to our Middle School Coaches as well as to still fully fund all the NMYSA expenses that we incurred. We are looking forward to running this program again and we have been notified that the funding from the City of Albuquerque is still earmarked for us to return!

# State Cup/NM Cup

State Cup 2019 registration finished out with 81 teams and our use of new software (GotSoccer) for registration, scheduling and seeding for this event turned out great! Unfortunately, COVID cancelled kickoff for State Cup and registration for NM Cup. I am looking forward to running these events for this coming year and we now have in house equipment and ideas to make NM Cup the experience that our membership was used to having with the likes of Target Cup and Kohl's Cup.

#### Wellfest 2019

I also attended a new event called Wellfest in partnership with Presbyterian and ran a mini soccer program alongside our "booth that we had set up. In this event I passed out over 200 flyers and giveaway items to parents interested in signing up for NMYSA affiliates. I was also able to sign up 2 referees and 5 coaches. I will be looking to options to expand our presence further in events like this including the use of the Innovate to Grow Grant to fund registration events that our members are having.

# Doublegood Popcom Fundraiser (ODP)

We ran a successful first-time fundraising event for our ODP program with the Doublegood popcorn company. The goal was to hopefully offset some needed expenses with ODP venues. We raised \$5,054 using this fundraiser and it was a big help to offset those ODP expenses.

## Innovate to Grow (Panna Cage/Futsal)

We received the Innovate to Grow Grant again this year and it was used to purchase a Panna Cage and equipment for Futsal. This will be used in registration events for interested members across the state and could also be used at NMYSA run events such as NM Cup. We will receive the cage in the upcoming months and recently received our PA System for this!



## Game Manager Course

I was also able to teach the Game Manager Course to 70+ new candidates in the Albuquerque area they will be able to manage U5-U8 games for their local league. We will be offering this class to interested clubs and leagues across the State. This will be a vital program for Spring 2021 to offset both the abysmal referee numbers we are seeing in our state and the increased need for referees due to the simultaneously run Club, High School, Collegiate and Mid School Soccer that will intersect all at once this year.
