The pandemic has had its effects on so many, but the soccer community has proven resilient and rallied together to bring youth soccer back to New Mexico, YES! It has been an exciting year at New Mexico Youth Soccer Association as we are finally able to play soccer with very few restrictions. It has not been an easy, but we are eager to continue to support the many volunteers, coaches, officials, and administrators that provide quality soccer experiences for the youth in New Mexico, and we are extremely thankful for their steadfastness through this rough patch. NMYSA will continue to focus on reengagement, and we will do our upmost to on grow the game in our communities! Our staff is committed to the NMYSA mission, "to foster a safe environment for the physical, mental, and emotional growth and development of New Mexico's youth through the sport of soccer at all levels of age and competition", and we remind ourselves often.

NMYSA

Although NMYSA will begin the new season with staff changes, we are confident that we will be ready to move forward with the same level of service as in the past. As many know, Michael Posen, Programs Administrator, will be leaving NMYSA to pursue a fantastic opportunity with Colorado United Soccer Club. Michael has been a tremendous asset to NMYSA and will be sorely missed, but we begrudge him not—this is a fantastic opportunity for Michael, and we wish him the best. Michael was instrumental in bringing our two futsal tournaments to fruition and introducing E-sports events to our members. He also traveled with our Panna Cage to outlying areas and continued the necessary work with the Middle School Leagues, NMYSA Cup, State Cup, Chaired TOPSoccer and became the "GotSport" guru among other things. We hope to continue what Michael started and strengthen all NMYSA programs! Best wishes to Michael in his new endeavors!

Registration numbers have fallen in New Mexico due primarily to the pandemic. However, all but a couple of our member leagues ran fall programs, and we surpassed our projected registrations of 15,500, by over 2000, (17792). We did have some compliance issues that we will continue to address for next season, (due mostly to training issues on the new Sports Connect platform). Mysha Crowley, State Registrar, worked diligently to get all registrars trained and onboarded to the new platform, and has done a tremendous job of working through the new compliance issues from SafeSport/USSF. Our thanks and appreciation to Mysha for her continued efforts and for providing support to all our registrars.

Rick Flores our Technical Director continues to surpass all NMYSA annual numbers of coaching courses completed/coach licenses issued. Rick does a fantastic job of engaging coaches and is a dedicated instructor spending many late evenings assisting coaches. Rick has rebuilt the ODP program with many new coaches, (that he has personally mentored through USSF licensing) and has re-established ODP training centers outside of the metro, (to bring more opportunities to players in outlying areas). He has also expanded the YOP program to different areas and continues his outreach to member leagues with instruction, camps, and free clinics. Rick is also the National TOPSoccer Technical Director and works with the Regional/National ODP programs. Rick will be administering our fledging "Intercity" league in the fall which we trust will be successful. Rick has proven to be an impactful member of the staff and we are grateful he is part of the NMYSA team!!

USYS/USSF



It has been a stable year for USYS with their leadership, (only lower-level staff changes) and we are beginning to see positive changes in programing and support from USYS. As for USSF, Cindy Parlow Cone was re-elected to another term as President of USSF in a close race against former USSF President Carlos Cordeiro. Many issues surfaced during the campaign that we believe will now be given attention by USSF. However, the current USSF CEO Will Wilson resigned this week so likely we will see some instability for a while to come, ugh! Good news though, the Women's National team Lawsuit has finally been resolved along with the Collective Bargaining Agreements for both the women's and men's national teams. Also, the Men's World Cup action begins in November in Qatar so we will finally have an opportunity to watch our USA Men's team in action.

Middle School Soccer Leagues

The Albuquerque Middle school league was played in a different format this year. Schools were given a choice of playing futsal or small sided games intraschool only due to restrictions from APS. However, the league was again fully funded by the City and the budget allowed for much needed equipment purchases for each school, futsal goals, training tops, full-sized goals, Pugg goals, paint and sprayers, pennies, cones, and balls. We look forward to next year's format of traditional outdoor soccer for MS.

This was a fantastic year for Las Cruces Middle School Soccer. The fledging league was a tremendous success and is on track for another season with more "buy in" from the city and the Las Cruces Public Schools. Thanks to everyone that stepped up to make the MS league happen, CW Ward, Eric Crespin, Erik Tuchfarber, Dreaux Plair and many more. Your advocacy for this program has finally paid off.

We are still exploring the possibility of a Northern area MS league and look forward to working with our northern members to see this league actualized.

TOPSoccer

In April we were honored to host the West and Mid-West TOPSoccer Symposium at the Tamaya Resort, in Santa Ana. We had over 50 attendees from around the country, (some came from South and East regions), but all enjoyed the presentations, Training courses, the camaraderie and networking. Congratulations to Ken LaCasse for the successful start of the Farmington TOPSoccer program. Also, thank you to Mike and Rick for making this event impactful to the attendees. We are thrilled that Hobbs Youth Soccer will be reactivating their TOPSoccer program as well.

State Cup/NMYSA Cup

In May we hosted 82 teams at the New Mexico Soccer Tournament Complex for a fun filled weekend at the NMYSA Cup, (a USYS United Cup) and 64 teams over two weekends for the New Mexico State Cup. Thanks to the NMYSA staff Mysha, Mike and Rick, and NMYSA Board members, Jim Cooper, for manning the Panna Cage at NMYSA Cup, Ron Guadette and Rennae Ross for field marshaling, and Tom Dickerson for scorekeeping all three weekends and for his work as tournament director of both events. Tom has dedicated so much time, before, during and after the events to ensure the success of hosted tournaments. Also, thanks to Sonya Flores, Barbara Gesner, Roger Pare, Evan Guadette and Denessa Posen for keeping the spectators in line and to Paul and Linda Quan for assigning and onsite support, and to Matthew Shappard for coming up to officiate. It really does take a Village!

Although State Cup was the smallest numbers we have seen in a couple of decades, 64 teams total, we managed to qualify 13 teams to represent New Mexico at the Far West Regionals in Boise Idaho for the 13U and above and Scottsdale Arizona for the 12U teams. We are thrilled to have many new teams/clubs



at the event and are proud of the champions from the NM Rush Soccer Club, (including Amarillo Rush, (7 teams), Rio Rapids (4 teams), NMSA (2 teams), AYSO United (1 team), Classic FC (1 team), and AUFC Thorns (1team). Congratulations 2022 NM State Champions!

Sponsorships/Grants

We have continued partnerships with Adidas, Soccer.com, Trace, Visit Albuquerque Sports Commission, Stack and signed new agreements with Simply Good, (one year) that will yield us \$24,000 in promo/In-kind, and \$21,000 cash for a total of \$45,000.

This year, we applied for and have been awarded Grants for TOPSoccer, of \$1, DICKS Community Grants, \$7,000 cash \$1,500 GC, USYS NMYSA United Cup, \$3,000, USYS Organizational Growth Grant, \$17,500, and a USSF Innovate to Grow Grant of \$27,000 (for referee recruitment and retention 22-23), for a total of \$57,100. We are extremely fortunate to have these partnerships and Grant opportunities and know they are not guaranteed each year, so we continue to work towards program sustainability and long-term impact.

General

Many of you know, 2022 Started off somberly at NMYSA when we lost our longtime friend and NMYSA Board member, Monty Randolph. Monty was a giant in the Hobbs Youth Soccer community and a tremendously valued volunteer/mentor on NMYSA's Board of Directors for almost two decades. Monty gifted us all his friendship, hard work and dedication and he will be fondly remembered by us all.

As we start a new chapter at NMYSA, we welcome NMSYA Board members, Heather Starr who will assume the role of Financial Officer, and Rennae Ross who will be our new President. Although our outgoing President Pat Switzer will be around as Immediate Past President, we want to extend our heartfelt thanks to Pat for his tremendous contributions to NMYSA, his 8 years of leadership as President, and his support/guidance of the NMYSA Staff. We would also like to celebrate Tom Dickerson for his many years of service to NMYSA. Tom has been in many roles with NMYSA including President, Financial Officer, and chair of many committees. Tom's dedication to youth soccer, specifically NMYSA is commendable. We know both Tom and Pat will continue to contribute in new ways to the success of NMYSA.

We also want to recognize the entire NMYSA board of Director who work behind the scenes to ensure NMYSA is a successful organization. We appreciate everything you do for NMYSA and the New Mexico soccer communities you represent. Thank you!
