As always, we are here to serve our membership and are looking forward to improvements and initiatives in the coming year.

Annual General Meeting February 3, 2024 Gloria Faber Executive Director

It has been a fantastic start of the 23-24 season with registrations trending up compared to this time last year. Fingers crossed that NMYSA's 23-24 season will show increased participations. At the regional and National levels, numbers are slightly down but both USYS and US Soccer are working to capture our participation numbers so that they can help with analytics, growth, and program trends as well as sponsorships. All agree that we must work together to grow the game of soccer in the United States.

#### **NMYSA**

We began the new season with our **mini grant** program to help our member affiliates with growth and sustainability. So far, several leagues have taken advantage of the mini grant program to purchase equipment and help with scholarships among other things. Funds are still available so we hope all member affiliates will apply for these Grants.

We are finally back to full staff with our recent hire of Chad Tyson who is our Programs Administrator/Operations Manager. We welcomed Chad in late August and are thrilled to have his marketing expertise and operations experience in the Programs Department. Chad recently managed our first NMYSA esports State Cup which was a fantastic success with 20 participants. The esports event was in collaboration with New Mexico State University and our partners at ESOGA. The final matches were broadcast live on You Tube and were a blast to watch.

In Late September, we moved our website platform from Active to NBC Sports Engine. The Active product was unfortunately not being serviced regularly so when the NBC opportunity came up with USYS, we jumped on the free offering. Under the USYS contract with NBC, we will not pay for hosting/service for as long as the USYS contract is in place, (currently 5 years). We are still working on some kinks in the migration so if you see something not working, please let us know. Thanks to Bill Flor for his expertise as we "flipped the switch" to the new platform.

Applications are open for our New Mexico Futsal State Cup, (March 10, 2024), New Mexico Open State Cup, (May 4 & 5, 11 & 12, 18 & 19), and the NMYSA Cup on (May 18 & 19, 2024). If opted in, the winners of the NM Open State Cup will travel to Honolulu, Hawaii for the Far West Regionals in June 2024. Regional winners will travel to Nationals in Orlando Florida at the ESPN Disney facility. Last July, we had a New Mexico wildcard team, U19 girls Rush, travel to Orlando for Nationals at the ESPN facility and all had a blast competing against the best soccer players in the nation.



Futsal is growing in New Mexico and what was once a sparsely and informally played sport, is now a growing off-season sport with multiple leagues that are flourishing. We are excited to see futsal frow and will continue to support the league with an annual Futsal State Cup!

Middle School soccer is also still growing in the metro areas with the Las Cruces Middle School Soccer League continuing for yet another season. Shout out to the Las Cruces Youth Soccer Association for the continued success of their MS league. The APS Middle Soccer league is entering its 5<sup>th</sup> full season with 28 schools/56 teams participating. We continue to partner with ABC Community Schools/City of Albuquerque/Bernalillo County/APS Schools to ensure the leagues success. The NMYSA MS league is fully funded by the City of Albuquerque and is serving over 1000 mid school kids across the city. If you are interested in starting a school program, Middle School or Elementary, please reach out, we would love to help!

We continued to contract with Alex Del Campo to visit member affiliates with the Panna Gage. If you would like to have the Panna Cage at an event you are hosting, please let us know. Also, Rick Flores has been visiting many of our member leagues but if you would like a clinic, grassroots course or want any of us to visit your league for training or meetings, please call us as we are here to serve you!

Lack of playing fields has been an ongoing theme/concern for many of our member affiliates. Closures, maintenance and increase demand have left us all scrambling for playing and practice fields. Most of our affiliates have established very good working relationships with their local city parks and recreational departments but if you need assistance, NMYSA is dedicated to helping our affiliates navigate local and state governments to help meet the facility needs of the soccer communities.

### USYS/USSF

It has been a productive year for USYS as they have just completed their Strategic Plan and are modifying some of their programs and offerings. There have been many discussions on relevancy and modernization. We have been fortunate to have a seat at the table for many of those discussions as I currently serve as the USYS Governance and Nominating Committee Chair, USYS Strategic Planning Committee Member, and most exciting Co-Chair of the USYS Technology Taskforce. Along with other voices from state associations, we are making progress in the right direction collectively. For the first time in many years, the relationship between USYS and USSF has strengthen primarily due to the openness and engagement of USSF leadership and staff. USYS and other federation affiliates are in conversations about unity and game growth. We all understand that it is incumbent upon us to figure out the best paths forward for soccer in the US. We all have a part in the success of soccer. US Soccer is implementing the recommendations that came about from the Sally Yates investigation and NMYSA is helping to pilot one of those programs, Safe Soccer. US Soccer is also working towards capturing participation data through registration and has a motivated staff working to make that happen. The USYS Technology Task Force has met with US Soccer and are working collaboratively to see this project through



### Sponsorships/Grants

For the 2023-2024 season, we continued our partnerships with Adidas, Soccer.com, Visit Albuquerque Sports commission, Sports Pin International and Kroger/Simple Truth which helps tremendously with our bottom line, (\$22,500 cash and \$26,000 in kind and promo).

We are still operating under two Innovate to Grow Grants, one finishing up within the next few months, (Panna Cage/Futsal) and the other we hope will continue for another year to help with Referee recruitment and retention. We will apply for DICKS Community Grants this year not only for NMYSA but for the Four Corners and Las Cruces areas, (must have a DICKS Store in your area). Fortunately, NMYSA received, "Employee Retention Credits", of just over \$60,000 which helped us purchase the new NMYSA vehicle and fund the NMYSA Mini Grant program.

### Partners/vendors

As you know, we are still partnering with Stack/Sports Connect/Stack Officials for our registration/event/assigning software, and they have proven to be fantastic partners over the years. Their service to our organization is exceptional. Thanks to Alec Cruickshank and all the staff at Stack Sports for your support! We have also continued our partnership with Players Health Insurance. They are considered the best of the best in the soccer industry. They go above and beyond to help State Associations manage and mitigate risks and have even help NMYSA with revamping our Risk Management Policies. Thank you, Dan Pullen, and the staff, at Players Health. We also have a new partnership with Sonesta Hotels in the Albuquerque area. Sonesta has two properties in the Albuquerque and are providing discounted hotel rates for our members. You can use the code for personal use as well, (2NMYSA). ### Referees/NMSRC

We have had several changes to the NMSRC over the last few months, Aaron Ostic resigned his role as Director of Instruction and was replaced by Rowdy Davis. Pat Switzer resigned his role as State Referee Administrator, and we are still looking to fill that role. Chris Frazier resigned as the State Director of Assessments/Mentors. At the last SRC meeting, a decision was made to combine duties of the Director of Assessment with those of the Director of Upgrades and to seek a separate person for the Director of Mentors, (still open). Thanks to Aaron Ostic, Pat Switzer, and Chris Frazier for your service and thanks to the dedication of those individuals that have stepped up to serve on the State Referee Committee. This group has come together to solve the referee shortages and are committed to developing New Mexico referees. We are grateful for all you do to keep the referee program thriving! Oh, NMYSA will be sending 8 referees to Far West Regionals in Hawaii this year. An application process has been set up on the SRC website. If you are currently officiating youth games and are prepared/qualified to officiate higher level games, please apply at www.nmsra.org.



### General
